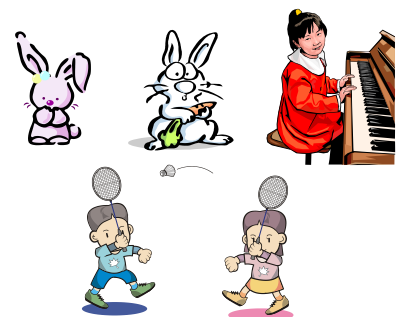

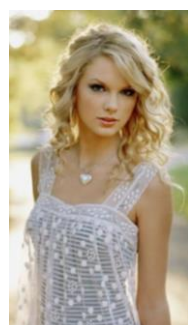
My Favourite Artist By: Fanny Wong (5A)
