Winnie finds five dollars in her pocket. They can buy the toy car. They feel happy. They give the toy car to David. He likes it very much.




### At the Cake Shop

#### 5A Tam Nicole Moon Interesting places in Hong Kong


Hong Kong has many interesting places. We can see and do a lot of things.

Hong Kong has many interesting places. I love Hong Kong!


#### 6A Jenny Wong Wai Heung An Accident


### 4A Macy Mai Tsz Ching School Picnic


### 5A Melody Cheung Wai Wan School Picnic



### 6A Christy Ho Cheuk Lamm
