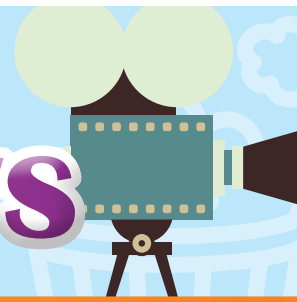
LKKB STEM BUS Renovation Begins!

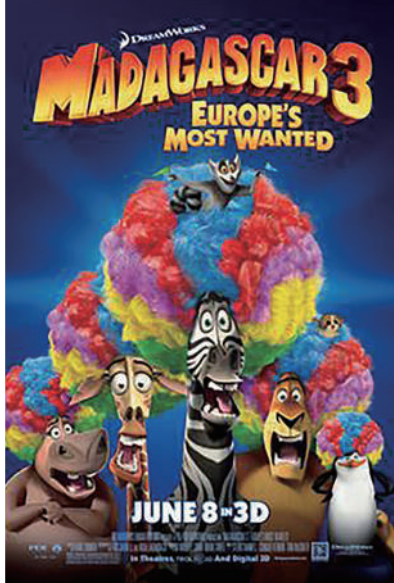


Film Reviews

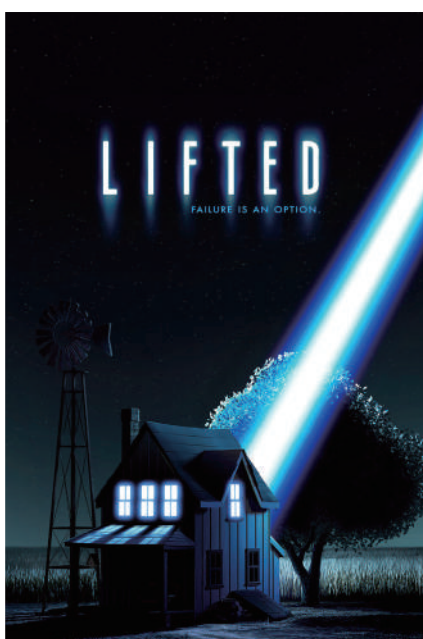

I think this job is suitable for me because I am caring and hard-working. I am strong too. I hope I can be a vet someday.

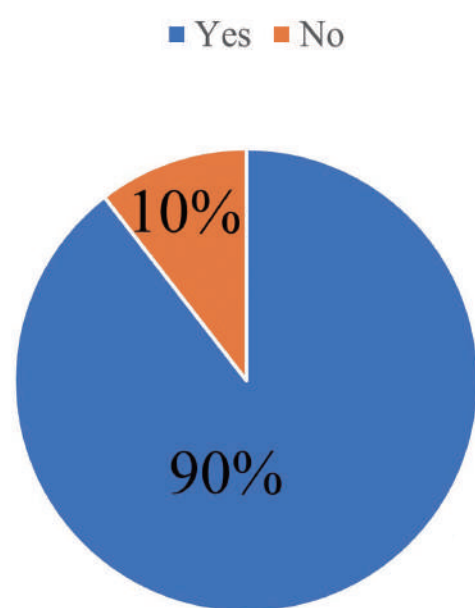
Survey Report: How COVID-19 Has Affected Students in LKKKB?

In January, our newspaper team did a survey about the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on our fellow schoolmates. We received 105 Microsoft Forms responses. Here are the results.

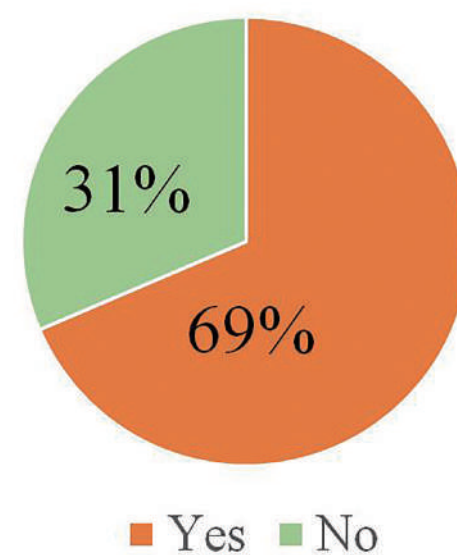
Q1. Do you feel scared of getting COVID-19?

Most students, about 90% of the respondents, are scared of getting COVID-19. To our surprise, 10% of them are not scared of getting the disease.

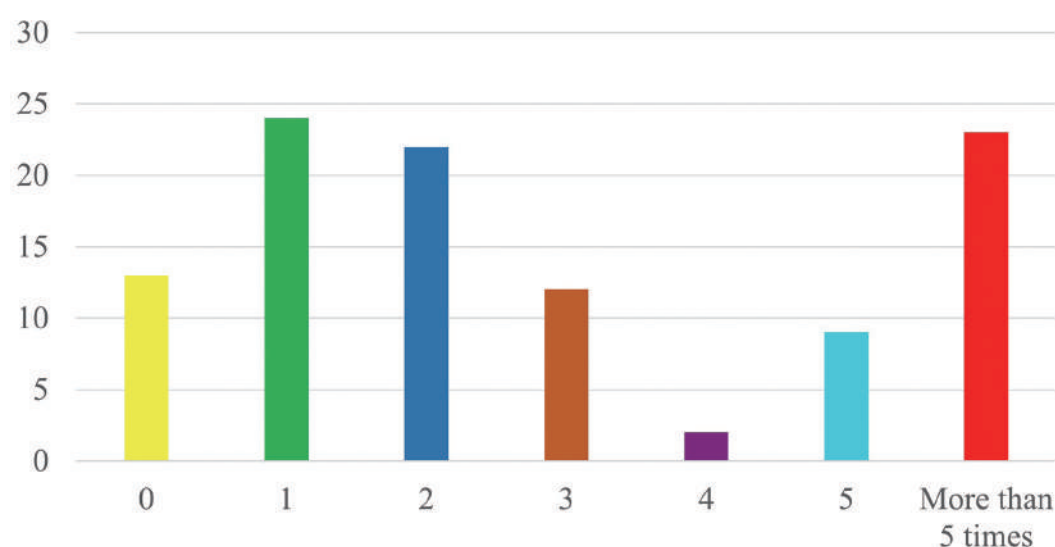


Q2. Are you bored of being at home?

During the pandemic, most people around the world have to stay at home to prevent the spread of coronavirus. Many people are bored of being at home. In our school, more than half of the students find staying at home boring. Only 31% of them are not bored of being at home.

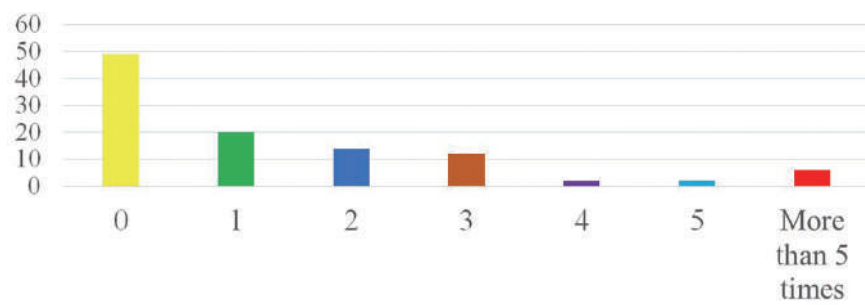


Q3. During the pandemic, how often do you go out in a week?



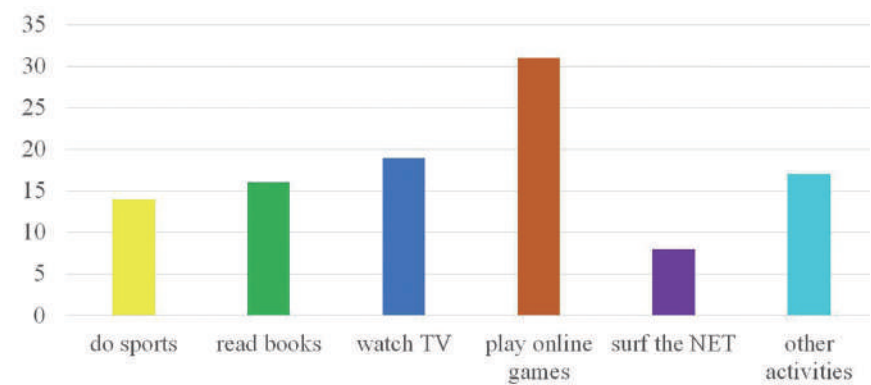
13 students told us that they never go out during the pandemic. About one-fourth of them go out more than five times a week.

About 50 students never dine out during the pandemic. About 40% of them eat out 1-3 times every week.

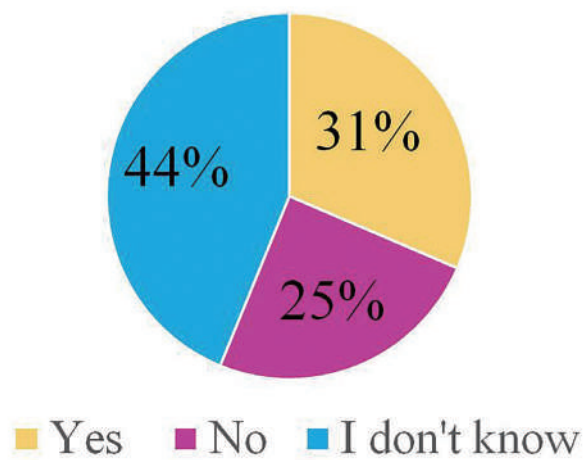
Q5. What do you do in your free time?



The most popular free time activity during the pandemic is playing online games. Some students watch TV, read books and do sports to kill time.

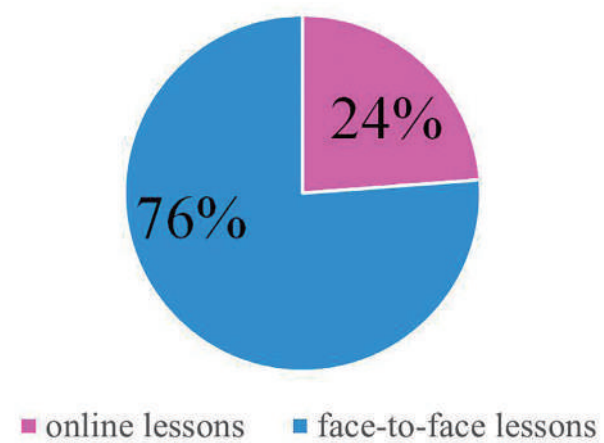
Q6. Does COVID-19 affect the income of your family?

The pandemic has affected the global economy. Some people lost their jobs. 31% of our respondents' family now have a lower income since the pandemic started.



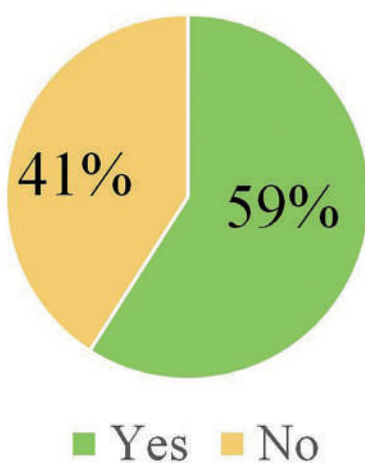
Q7. Which do you prefer, online lessons or face-to-face lessons?
