

文化小知識:二十四節氣









甚麼是二十四節氣?二十四節氣,是曆法中表示自然節律變化。一歲四時,<u>春夏秋冬</u>各三個月,每月兩個節氣,每個節氣均有其獨特的含義,也四節氣準確的反映了自然節律變化,在人們日常生活中發揮了極為重要的作用。它不僅是指導農耕生產的時節體系,更是包含有豐富民俗事象的民俗系統

二十四節氣是一個統稱,其中包括十二個中 氣和十二個節氣,中氣和節氣相間地排列。從春 分起十二個中氣分別是春分、穀雨、小滿、夏至、 大暑、處暑、秋分、霜降、小雪、冬至、大寒和 雨水,分屬於十二個以地支排列的月份。 春分 後的節氣是清明,其後的節氣依次是立夏、芒種、 小暑、立秋、白露、寒露、立冬、大雪、小寒、 立春和驚蟄。




