An Accident at Home

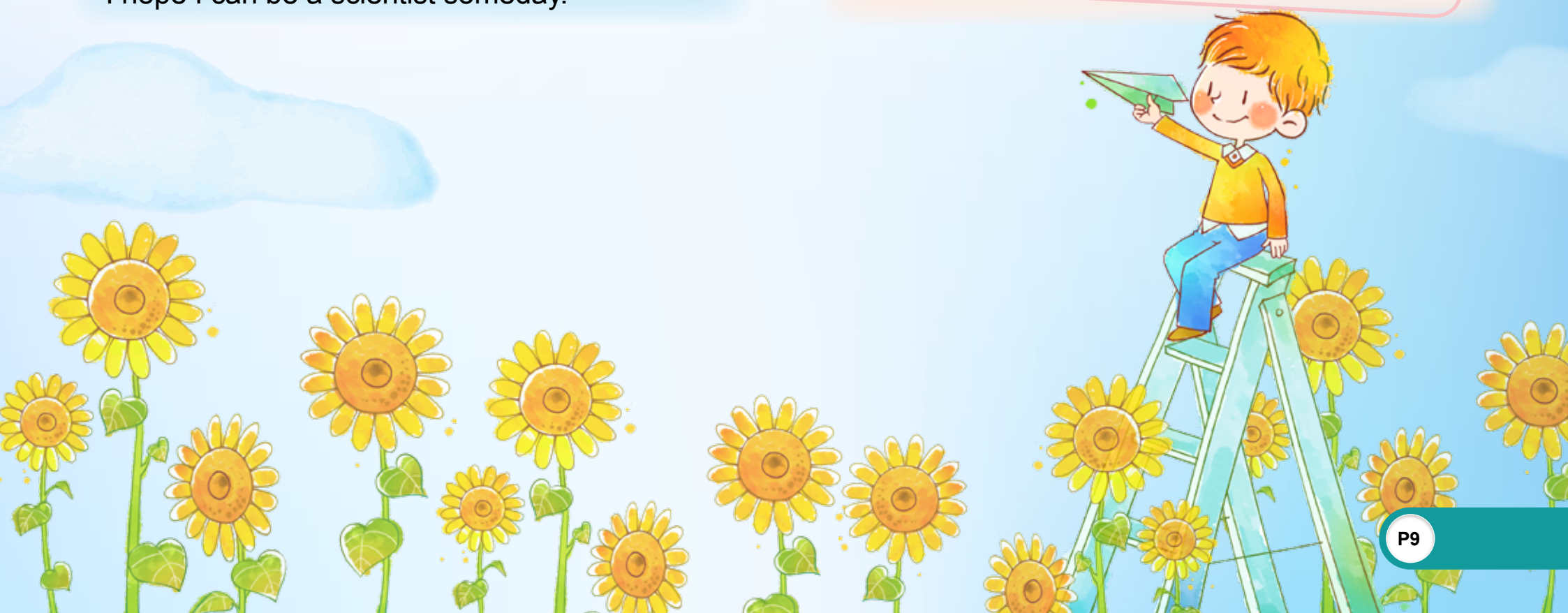
John Henry 6B



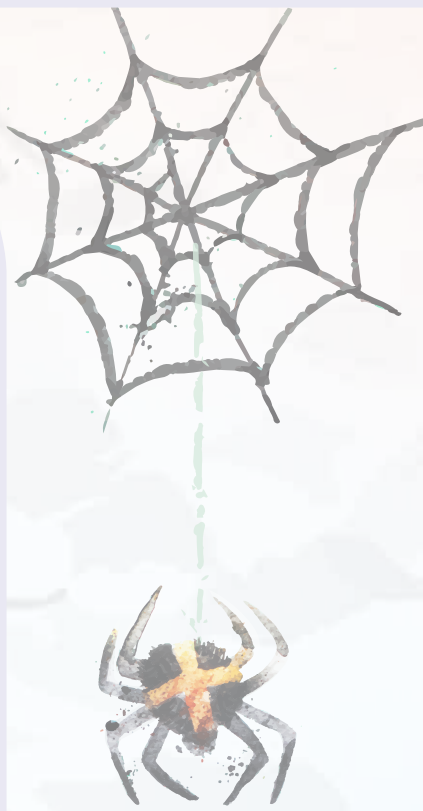
I jumped up from my bed, 'Ha! It was only a dream! It's not real!' Then, I went to school. At school there was a man called Scream. I was worried!

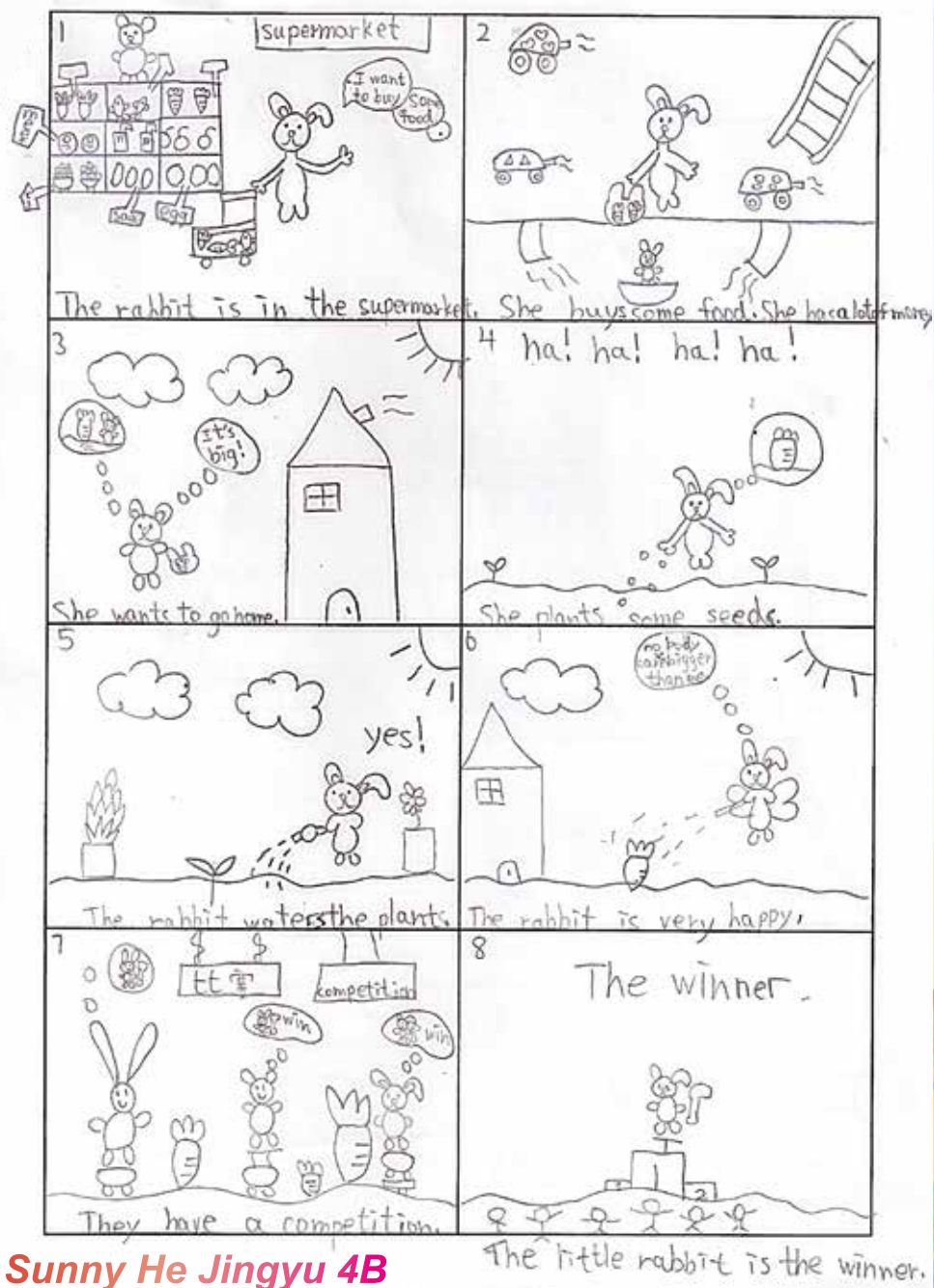
