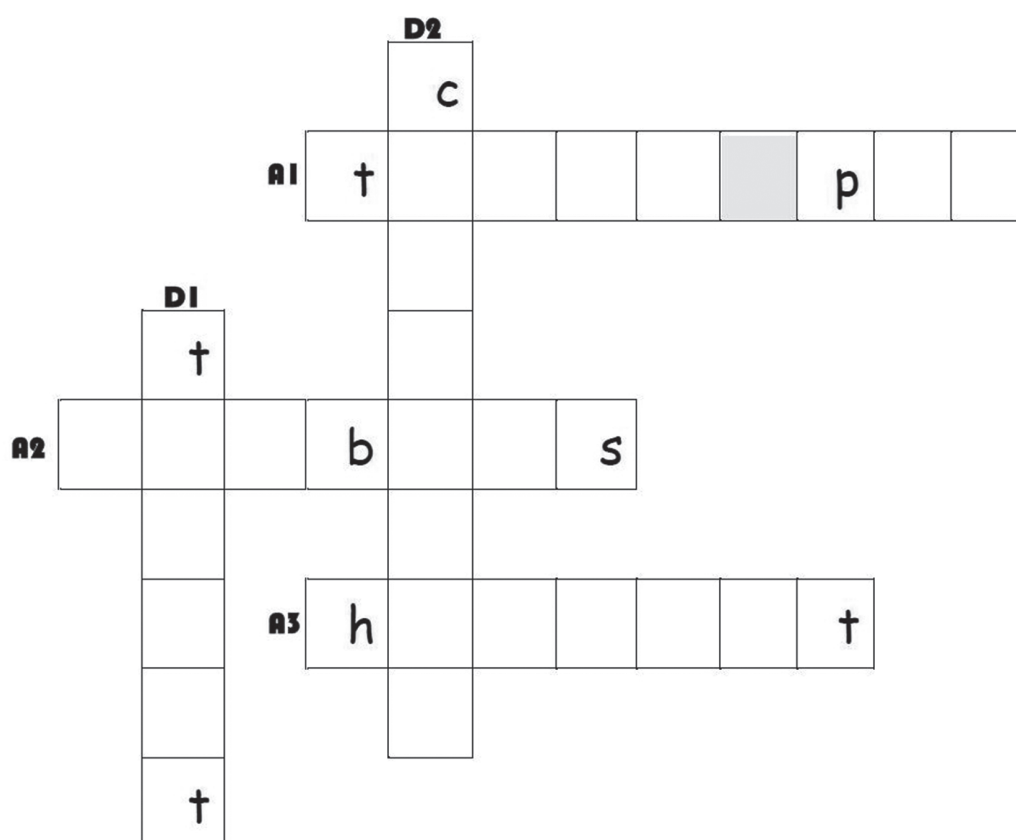

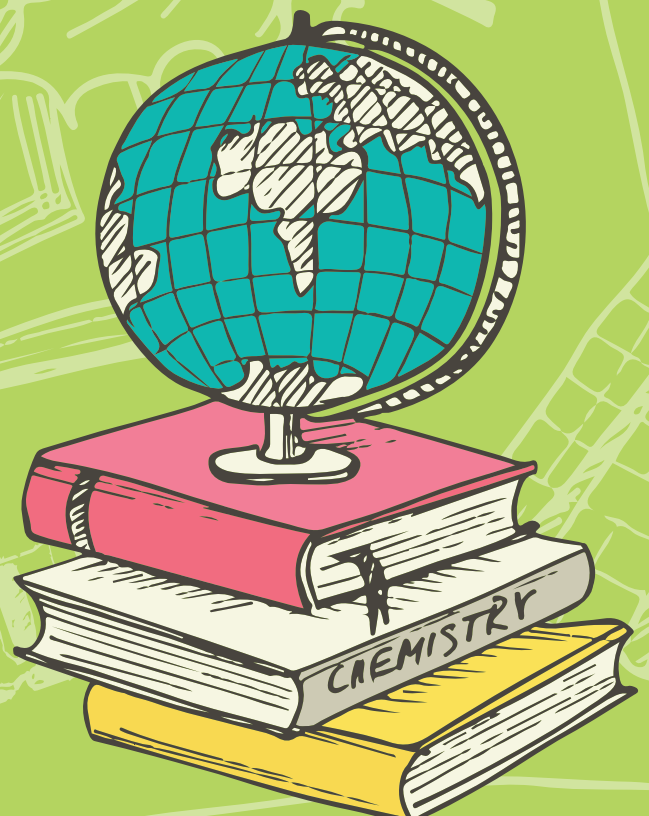

Science Fiction Park is divided into three zones: Scary Land, Fun Land and Space Learning Land. Let's visit Scary Land first.

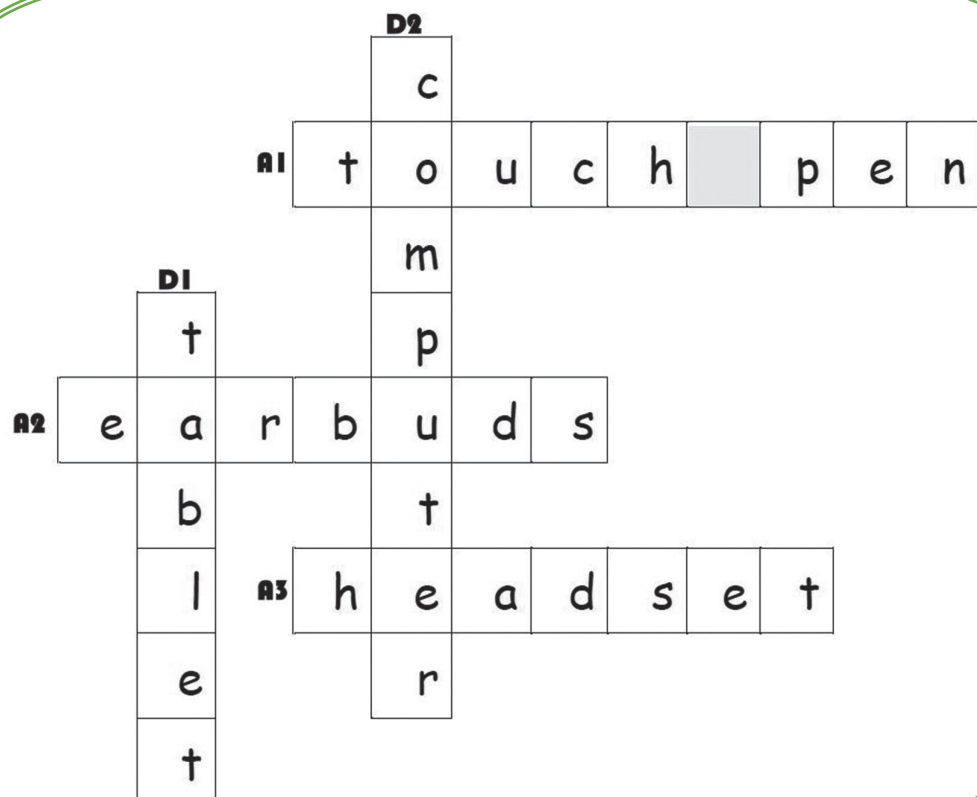

Food Survey

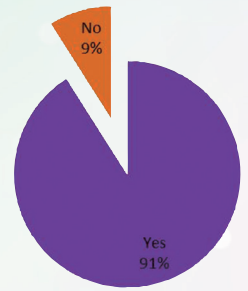

Q3. How much do you spend on snacks in a week?

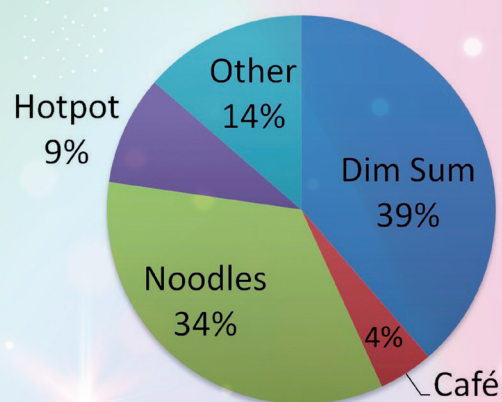
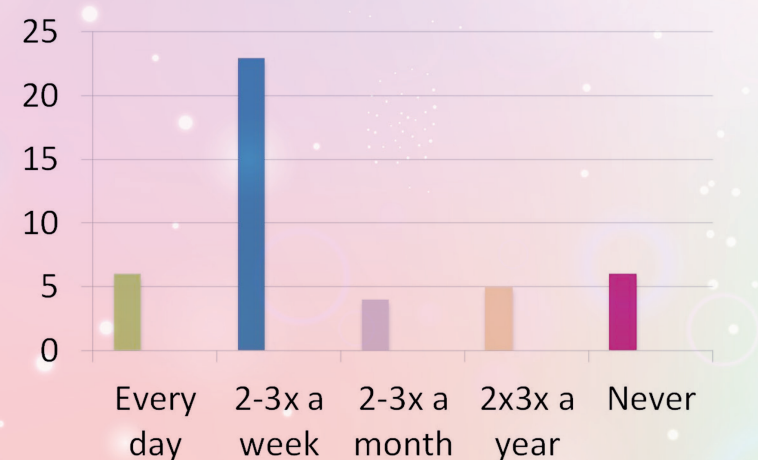

Q5. What is your favourite Chinese food?

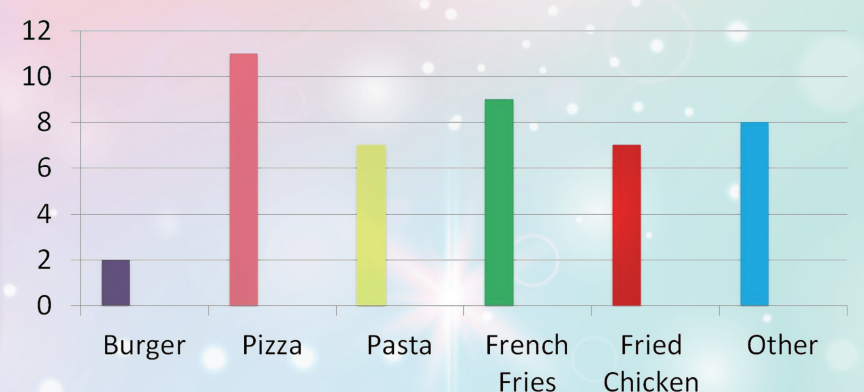
